- 1 vowel alone or preceded by a consonant
- Long vowel sound
- Coded with a macron —

V CV CCV
CCC V

Silent e Syllables

- Vowel – consonant – e
- E controls the sound of the first vowel
- First vowel is long
- E is silent

—
VCe CVCe

Consonant – le Syllable

- At the end of a polysyllabic word
- Last syllable ends in – le
- Never accented
- E is not sounded
- Count back 3; look for a consonant – le
- Divide with a [



Vowel Team Syllables

- 2 vowels paired together giving 1 sound
- Regular Vowel Teams - ai first vowel long second vowel silent

- Irregular Vowel Teams - short vowel sound or first vowel silent and second vowel long
- Vowel Digraphs or diphthongs - oi, oy
